

DUTIES OF THE CAPTAINS

Ensure a complete team of at least two (2) regular team members and two (2) subs are ready for each match at the official time. Subs are to be selected from the official sub list. If you can only produce a team of three (3) players (must have at least two regular team members plus a sub), you can play three times with three (3) players during a season. Any further games with three players will be forfeited.

If Home team, assign someone from your team to keep score on the scoreboard. If your team is the visiting team, designate someone from your team to oversee the scoring. Any discrepancies must be decided before the pallino is tossed for the next frame.

Flip a coin to begin the match. The winner of the flip chooses either the color of the balls or the first toss of the pallino.

It is your duty to remind team members that all balls must be placed in the ball holders before the beginning of each frame. Failure to do so may result in the stopping of play until balls are placed in the holders and then the frame will be restarted.

If necessary, to measure distance between ball and pallino, you may delegate this to another team member. In any case, only two people (one from each team) are allowed on the court to do the measuring. Only tape measures provided by the league are to be used for all measurements.

When you are the "Home Team", complete score the sheet and return it to the Captain in Charge (CIC) at the end of the match. Return all equipment (balls, pallino, cage, tape measure) to the storage box.

You must be familiar with SCABC "Rules and Policies"

Captains of the two teams playing are to settle all disputes between themselves. If they cannot agree, then play continues for the rest of the game(s) and either captain may submit a protest in writing within 24 hours to the Bocce Board of Directors.
